

Chair Positions: Common Crossings

Notes:

1. The special crossing chairs are lettered Y, X, A, B, C, D and E. They are positioned at right angles to the common crossing centre line and so can be applied to both RH and LH crossings.
2. The special chairs are designed to be at a spacing of 2ft 6in (10mm) and this decides the spacing of the timbers under the crossing.
3. These chair mouldings are designed for P4 track standards and some adjustments may need to be made if they are used on track with wider flangeways.
4. When using the special chair sprues, make sure you have sorted out which moulding goes where - some of the sprue labels make it possible to get confused.
