Chair Positions: Common Crossings

Notes:

- 1. The special crossing chairs are lettered Y, X, A, B, C, D and E. They are positioned at right angles to the common crossing centre line and so can be applied to both RH and LH crossings.
- 2. The special chairs are designed to be at a spacing of 2ft 6in (10mm) and this decides the spacing of the timbers under the crossing.
- 3. These chair mouldings are designed for P4 track standards and some adjustments may need to be made if they are used on track with wider flangeways.
- 4. When using the special chair sprues, make sure you have sorted out which moulding goes where some of the sprue labels make it possible to get confused.
